Over a century ago, L'Unione Italiana was founded by a small visionary group who realized that by uniting together, the Italian community of Tampa could overcome many of the social and economic challenges that confronted those "turn-of-the-century" immigrants from Italy. Since reaching our 100 year anniversary of this venerable organization, we now become the turn-of-the-century Italians. Because of the courage, imagination, resiliency and pride that our ancestors brought to this country and instilled in us, we find ourselves, so much better off socially, economically and educationally than our immigrant ancestors were. The image of the gaunt, threadbare, and downtrodden immigrants carrying suitcases has been replaced by the appearance of thriving, fashionable, and confident entrepreneurs, educators and professionals carrying briefcases.

The significant transformation in both the status and the stature of Tampa's Italian-American community, now well into its fifth generation, has provided us with new challenges, evolving needs, and concerns much different than those which faced our predecessors. As a result, the formulas by which L'Unione Italiana has operated for over a century no longer effectively served the needs of modern Italians. Since L'Unione Italiana does indeed, aspire to serve the modern Italians as effectively as it served those early immigrants, we must re-direct our goals to reflect more accurately the interests, identities and profiles of today's Italian-American population. The challenge is to modernize our focus, without abandoning or disregarding the rich heritage that has contributed to what we are today.

The mission of L'Unione Italiana is to preserve and honor the culture, traditions and heritage of the Italian Community and to maintain the historical facility as a functioning memorial to the working class immigrants. We will support this mission through the dues and contributions provided by the members, their families, friends, and government. In return, we will add value to the membership by providing social activities, fellowship, Italian arts and culture; these activities will provide for growth and stability in the membership, creating a safe and comfortable environment for our members, their families, and the community.

When Tammy Modica, founder and CEO of Aeon Life Theater, first spoke to Mark Stanish, about moving her productions to the Italian Club, she knew it would be a good match. Mark immediately recognized the potential benefit to both the Club and to Aeon Life Theater – and Tammy felt a welcoming sense of community that let her know this was going to be the start of an amazing relationship. For an Italian girl whose great-grandparents immigrated from Sicily, working with such a culturally rich Club was a special bonus.



Ms. Modica strives for the best and is delighted to have found a home for Aeon Life as the resident theater company of the Italian Club. When she created her professional community theater company in 2015, she built it on the belief that “amateur theater doesn’t have to be amateurish”, though the idea for Aeon began many years before. After working with a number of other community theaters, she wanted to produce something greater that would connect with the larger Tampa Bay community while having fun doing it.

With a motto of “never just be; be greater”, she set rigorous standards to reflect a commitment to excellence in every area of production. She treats each cast and crew member like family – often like an Italian family with a little shouting, some food and good wine, but always with a warm laugh and welcoming safe space.

“Our mission,” she says, “is to celebrate life through storytelling, community involvement, and personal growth.” An “aeon” is described as an indefinite or very long period of time and Ms. Modica is looking forward to an aeon-long collaboration with the Italian Club. However, just performing at the Club isn’t enough for this dynamic theatrical troupe. Enthusiastically, they donate 50% of each production’s final performance directly back to the Club’s restoration fund. Ms. Modica has even begun talks with Mark to see what improvements, beyond the final performance’s donation, Aeon can do to help continue to revive the theater space and breathe life back into its wings.



CULINARY STUDENTS AND DIGNITARIES FROM BIVONA, SICILY VISIT TAMPA

For 13 days April 2019, Tampa-Agrigento Sister Cities Committee and Gaither High School's #Ciaotalia! hosted a delegation of twenty dignitaries and culinary students from Bivona, Agrigento, Sicily, as part of "Scuola-Lavoro". Sindaco (Mayor) Milko Cinà of Bivona was part of the delegation, accompanied by Vice-Sindaco Salvatore Cutro and Assessore Angelo Cannella. Delegation members met with Tampa Mayor Bob Buckhorn and Tampa City Council on April 4, 2019 in a Sister Cities celebration of shared culture and education. The "Scuola-Lavoro" program brought eight students and 5 school administrators/instructors from Bivona's Istituto di Istruzione Secondario Superiore "Luigi Pirandello" (High School) cooking program to share the

language and culture with Gaither High School's AP Italian Language and Culture education program and two food demonstrations hosted by Principal Thomas Morrill. The Scuola-Lavoro students also shared traditional secrets of fine Sicilian cuisine with Hillsborough County's Sickles High School Culinary Arts Program taught by Chef Rick and worked with local restaurateurs including the Osteria Bar & Kitchen, Bella's Restaurant and the Italian Club's cooking volunteers for Festa Italiana. The Scuola-Lavoro students visited University of South Florida's Professor Patrizia LaTrecchia's class of Italian, Food and Culture, Prof. Davide Tanasi's class of History and Archeology and Vigo Importing. Local host families opened their homes to Scuola-Lavoro students, offering them a taste of America, Florida beaches and bay area attractions. The trip culminated with a celebration of L'Unione Italiana Italian Heritage Day, April 6, 2019 where our visiting students provided cooking demonstrations to the public.

The Idea of this multicultural exchange came from the Belluccia family in Alessandria della Rocca, during the Sister Cities visit to Sicily last May with Mayor Bob Buckhorn. Making the idea a reality was made possible by Professoressa Giovanna Bubello, Principal of the Luigi Pirandello High School of Bivona; Vince J. Pardo and Alfonso Belluccia of the Tampa-Agrigento Sister Cities Committee; Katherine Grazier-Pescante, Italian Language Professor at Gaither High School, Hillsborough County Schools; the Organization for the Development of Italian Studies (ODLI) and local host families who opened their homes to the students. Additional support was given by numerous Tampa-based sponsors and benefactors, including The Italian Club, whose donations helped cover expenses.

The program is also looking for families who are interested in sending their high school aged children to Bivona next year, as well as families and businesses who are interested in helping with future exchanges.



To Italian Club Members and Their Families

Do you have fond memories of relatives that have passed on? The love and care they provided you and the times they comforted you are memories to be cherished. We all have these thoughts when something we see or hear reminds us of them. Your parents, grandparents, great-grandparents, uncles and aunts deserve to be remembered.

Most of these relatives were lovingly interred in a special resting place at The Italian Club Cemetery. Headstones were carefully designed to honor our loved ones. We mourned our loved ones in the beautiful location selected for them. In the past, visits to the cemetery, bringing flowers and caring for the headstones were frequent. Sadly, as time went by, the visits became less frequent and the care of the headstones wavered or simply ceased. As a result, the Cemetery is now showing its age and many of the headstones and grounds need attention and sprucing up.

The Italian Club's Cemetery Committee works hard to maintain the cemetery but cannot do it alone. Monthly maintenance expenses for the Cemetery are approximately \$2,500 per month / \$30,000 annually. These expenses cover common area grounds keeping, utilities and general infrastructure repairs. Even though family plots and headstones are the responsibility of family members, the Cemetery Committee has strived to assist in maintaining them. Volunteer cleanup days have been organized to assist with this effort, but much more needs to be done. This could easily be a family project where the expense could be shared.

To elicit family member and public support with the maintenance and esthetics of our historic cemetery, we have initiated the **ADOPT A GRAVE Program**. We ask that you participate in this program in the following ways:

Personally, maintain your family's gravesites including repairs (we can provide you with a source for repairs, pressure washing, etc.), and/or

Adopt one or more graves for as little as \$50.00 each annually. This **tax-deductible donation** can be made in memory of the name of your deceased love one(s). We will schedule cleaning and maintenance work on the neediest un-adopted grave sites.
